### Federal Audit

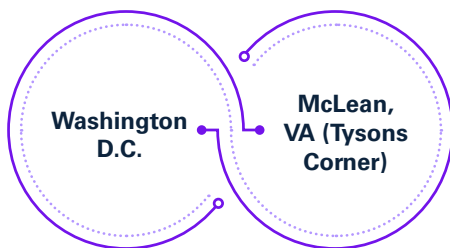
- Applicants must hold U.S. citizenship
- Federal Audit practice professionals work on Federal government entities for 6-8 months of year, with opportunities to work in Federal Advisory or Commercial Audit during downtime. Some clients can be year-round
- Most clients have a September 30th fiscal year end and must file their financial opinions by November 15th, with the Federal Audit “busy season” falling in between
- Opportunity to obtain a U.S. Security Clearance for some engagements
- Travel for site visits throughout the year
- Audit 9 of the 15 cabinet-level agencies

### Commercial Audit

- Work on public, private, and not-for-profit clients for majority of year
- Length of frequency of client assignments can vary
- Fiscal year end dates vary by client. While most clients have a December 31st year end with a winter “busy season,” others have June 30th or September 30th year end dates
- Travel for site visits throughout the year
- Diverse market share of client industries that include financial services, technology, media and telecommunication, aerospace and defense, real estate, and not-for-profit clients
